Course Overview

This experience is the culmination of the Masterclass Series delivered in collaboration with The Netherlands School of Public Administration. This transformative week moves people from the abstract work of theory into the complexity of real organisations. Engaging with complex and adaptive challenges allows participants to feel the pressures and expectations of agile leadership, identify the dynamics at play in underlying systems, and experience using the collective wisdom and diverse lenses of their group to surface issues and solve problems. Experiential learning within a European context affords participants a global governance perspective.

Who should attend

Chief and senior executives seeking expansion of their leadership perspectives and opportunities to take systems level understanding to a new level.

Outcomes

- Understand the governance and government of another country and expand global context for local work
- Integrate own experience with the perspectives of journey colleagues to inform personal research study
- Participate in an innovative live case study to see an issue from top to bottom, observe leadership across that system and see progressive approaches to public issues
- Deepen knowledge and application of research methodology

Course Content

The Live Case Study has been designed to explore issues around one particular public policy question – it is an experiential learning opportunity that immerses the participant in the system. The issue is real and both the international hosts and journey colleagues value each participant input and feedback. Following a series of informative lectures and discussions around the way in which local and national governments work, emerging cultural and sociological issues, and global influences - participants utilize a research methodology to observe, interrogate and analyse the topic across several host organisations in The Netherlands. This immersive fieldwork will enable participants to make sense of their own observations and identify their learning and insights before formally presenting their findings and feedback to their hosts. Upon completion, participants will be able to apply their learning and insights to leadership issues within their own organisations and practice.
