Crisis Leadership Focus

Professor Paul 't Hart is best-known for his research and teaching on crisis management and on public leadership. He has (co-)authored and (co-)edited 50 books, including the prize-winning The Pivot of Power: Australian Prime Ministers and Political Leadership, 1949-2016. He is a much sought-after international expert on crisis management.





Professor Paul 't Hart

Paul 't Hart is a Dutch Australian and is currently Professor of Public Administration at Utrecht University and Associate Dean of the Netherlands School of Public Administration in The Hague. He resumed both positions in mid-2011, after spending five years as Professor of Political Science at the Australian National University. Paul's research, teaching and consulting covers political and public sector leadership, policy evaluation, public accountability and crisis management.

He has extensive consulting experience within government, primarily in Holland, Sweden and Australia, including secondments at the Dutch Intelligence Service and Public Prosecutors Office. He gave evidence at the Royal Commission into the Victorian Bushfires. Paul has been a core faculty member of the Australia New Zealand School of Government since 2007 and the Executive Challenge Academy since 2011.

Paul regularly conducts workshops and lectures all around the Dutch and Australian public sectors, mostly on themes related to public leadership, crisis management, and political-administrative relations.

In 2016, Paul was awarded an Advanced Grant from the European Science Foundation for a 5-year programme investigating the nature and preconditions of highly successful public policies, public organisations and public collaborations.
