Professor Anne Tiernan is a leading political scientist. For the past 30 years she has worked across government, academia and industry. Her career, which has spanned strategy, research, policy and practice has been devoted to improving public policy and public purpose outcomes. Now Managing Director of missionled consultancy firm Constellation Impact Advisory, Anne consults regularly to organisations committed to purpose and positive impact. An Adjunct Professor at Griffith University and previously a member of the University's senior leadership team, Anne is a National Fellow of the Institute of Public Administration Australia, and a Fellow of the Australia and New Zealand School of Government (ANZSOG) and has held a range of Board appointments.

Workshop Preamble

Integrity and accountability are the foundation for trust and legitimacy of the institutions, processes, organisations and professions on whom individuals, communities and our democracies depend. And yet internationally, we face a crisis of trust that is eroding public confidence in some of our most important institutions -from politics and the media, to the care, educational and financial sectors, churches, community organisations and sporting clubs, among numerous others.

Numerous reports and a growing literature on how to address the crisis of trust highlight the importance of culture, responsibility and leadership in (re)building and sustaining public trust.

This workshop focuses on these, and on the imperative and the skills to 'think institutionally'. Using case-based exercises and a practical problem-solving approach, we explore how leaders can foster habits and practices that form and maintain the character and cultures that underpin high-trust institutions, on which the public and their members can safely rely.

Mark Strom has over 25 years of professional consulting and CEO experience and consults to corporations and government bodies on systems thinking, cultural change, learning and leadership. Liam is a CEO, writer and public speaker who specialises in helping organisations navigate transformational change. With a focus on engaging people through change, Liam specialises in working with communities in complex environments to achieve sustainable, just and desired futures. He is a Senior Fellow with the Centre for Postnormal Policy and Futures Studies and an Adjunct Industry Fellow for The School of Social Sciences, University of the Sunshine Coast.



Professor Paul 't Hart

Paul is a Professor of Public Administration at Utrecht University and Associate Dean of the Netherlands School of Public Administration in The Hague. He resumed both positions in mid-2011, after spending five years as Professor of Political Science at the Australian National University. Paul's research, teaching and consulting covers political and public sector leadership, policy evaluation, public accountability and crisis management.



Professor Sohail Inayatullah

Sohail is the inaugural UNESCO Chair in Futures Studies. He is a political scientist/ futurist at Tamkang University, Taipei; and an Associate at Melbourne Business School, the University of Melbourne. He was an Adjunct Professor at USC and from 2011-2014, an Adjunct Professor at the Centre for Policing, Counter-terrorism and Intelligence, Macquarie University, Sydney.
