What is a Live Case Study?

The Live Case Study (LCS) has been designed as a serious and enjoyable exploration of the issues presented by a core question that has been defined and clarified by a participant design team. The issues are real and journey hosts and colleagues hugely value participant input into the process. Participants will utilise one of the distinct research methodologies studied in a requisite Executive Masterclass to research and analyse various host organisations. The 2-day immersive fieldwork will enable participants to make sense of their own observations and identify their learning and insights before presenting their findings and feedback to their hosts. Upon completion, participants will be able to apply their learning and insights to issues within their own organisations and practice.
