

Monthly Learning Journey

Typically each month of the program follows a very clear path to facilitate learning for busy people. Our platforms allow participants to learn at their own pace.

Most content can be engaged with online. Live sessions such as orientation and class tutorials are recorded for playback if live attendance can't be achieved.

Modules are completed by viewing the content, completing assignments and engaging in discussions, taking an average 4-6 hours per month.


