What is Executive Challenge Academy (ECA)?

Today's leaders face challenges that are more global, fluid and multidimensional. Issues, including change, must be managed within an increasingly complex environment. Leaders also need to develop public, economic and social value of any organisation or the sector they lead. Effective leaders rely on learnings and networks that transcend geography, jurisdiction, profession and sector.

At ECA, you will step out of your everyday context and into a dynamic ongoing learning community. Here you will become steeped in new thinking and new ways of approaching your challenges, and make connections with innovative leaders from across sectors and around the world.

Women Leading in the Public & Community Sector: (with Christine Nixon & Amanda Sinclair)

This workshop aims to expand approaches to influencing and mobilising people, and to identify practical steps to deal with leadership challenges. While developing effectiveness and broadening your leadership repertoire, you will also be exposed to a lifelong network of likeminded public and community sector leaders, opening doors for future collaboration.

Looking outside traditional leadership models, Dr Nixon and Professor Sinclair aim to empower women to be role models for humane and people-centred leadership. Participants will learn from each other as well as experienced practitioners about leading change and upholding public purpose values.

What you will learn:

Over two days, Dr Nixon and Professor Sinclair will guide participants through the broad strategic levels of leadership and mobilising organisations, to managing groups, finishing on the personal dimensions of leadership roles.

Modules will include:

- strategies for reforming organisations and leading change
- overcoming common leadership challenges
- leadership during difficult times and crisis management
- tactics to build power and influence others

Management

- how to get new initiatives on the agenda
- working effectively in groups to solve challenges and mobilise change



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- Understanding group processes and how to intervene to achieve goals
- What distinguishes good managers, and modelling effective management

Personal Dimensions

- Cultivating presence & capacity to influence
- Mitigating the personal & professional risks
- Dealing with unconscious bias
- Practising mindfulness to build resilience
- Setting goals & creating and modelling sustainable practices

Dr Christine Nixon – As Monash University Deputy Chancellor and former Victorian Police Commissioner, Dr Nixon has a wealth of experience in leadership positions.

Professor Amanda Sinclair – author, researcher, teacher and consultant in the areas of leadership, change, gender and diversity. Professor Sinclair is currently a Professorial Fellow at Melbourne Business School, University of Melbourne.
