As the 19th Chief Commissioner of Victoria Police, she has direct experience of running a highly complex organisation through change, disruption and, at times, extreme circumstances. She was the first woman to become a police commissioner in Australia, leading 14,000 staff and oversaw an annual budget of \$1.7 billion.

Christine's workshop leadership comes from a rich career leading and studying crisis management, and in more recent times working with corporates, not-for-profits, universities, police, and health professionals in crisis management.

Truly a woman in leadership, Christine Nixon rose to the top in the male-dominated field of policing and can enthral an audience with her visible compassion, warmth, intelligence and determination.

Amanda is a widely published author, recognised in academic and corporate circles as a pioneer in diversity and women in leadership and explorer of the application of mindfulness in leadership. After completing her PhD in Political Psychology at the University of Melbourne, Amanda has worked as an academic and consultant, coaching individuals and senior management teams in the government and corporate sectors.
